## **UPDATED PUBLIC MEETINGS PROCEDURES – COVID-19**

Given executive orders from Governor Brown concerning COVID-19 and social distancing requirements, the City of Florence has established temporary procedures for public meetings in order to protect our volunteers, public and staff.

### **In person attendance is not allowed at Environmental Management Advisory Committee (EMAC) meetings.**

**Expressing Views to the Environmental Management Advisory Committee:** Citizens wishing to express their views to the EMAC may do so in both written and verbal formats.

1. **Written Testimony:** Citizens wishing to express their views are encouraged to submit written testimony in one of the following ways:

  - c. Drop off written comments to the City of Florence drop box located at Florence City Hall (250 Hwy 101) to the right of the main entrance.

**\*\* Note:** Written comments received at least 2 hours prior to the meeting (April 20, 2021 at 4:00 p.m.) will be distributed to the EMAC, posted to the City of Florence website, and made part of the record.

2. **Verbal Testimony:** Citizens wishing to express their views to the EMAC may participate in the meeting via GotoWebinar. To do so, please complete a speaker's card online at <https://www.ci.florence.or.us/bc-emac/request-address-environmental-management-advisory-committee-speakers-card> at least 1 hour prior to the meeting (April 20, 2021 at 5:00 p.m.). City staff will then contact the speaker to let them know the process to participate in the meeting.
  - a. **Public Comments on items not on the agenda:** General public comments (on items not on the agenda) will be allowed at each meeting during the public comment agenda item. Comments will be limited to three (3) minutes per person, with a maximum of 15 minutes for all items. In practicality, this means no more than five individuals will be allowed to comment verbally. There is no limit on written public comments.
  - b. **Public Comments on Action Items:** Public Comments will be allowed on each action item on the agenda. Verbal comments will be allowed on action items after staff has given their report and have allowed time for initial Committee questions. Comments will be limited to three (3) minutes per person, with a maximum of 15 minutes for all comments on each action item. In practicality, this means no more than five (5) individuals will be allowed to comment verbally. There is no limit on written public comments.

1. Topic Introduction by Chair/Vice Chair
2. Presentation of Topic by Presenter (Sub-Committee, Committee Member, Staff)
3. Questions Asked of Presenter by Committee
4. Public Input if an Action Item (voting item)
5. Policy, Code, Budget and Procedure Input by Staff
6. Follow-Up Questions Asked by Committee of Presenter/Staff in light of additional input
7. Committee to set Follow-up Action/Direction -or-
8. A Member makes a Motion and a member Seconds it if a voting topic
9. Committee Discussion
10. Committee members vote by roll call
11. If the vote is split evenly or the vote fails and the topic requires a positive vote/action to move forward such as a recommendation to Council on a solid waste rate change then return to #8 above for a new motion
