Tsunami Evacuation Planning Community Survey

In light of the threat of a Cascadia Subduction Zone (CSZ) earthquake and resultant tsunami looming over Oregon, the City, in cooperation with the Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLCD), is undertaking a project to develop a Tsunami Evacuation Facilities Improvement Plan (TEFIP) for the City.

This plan addresses the full range of considerations related to evacuation needs and infrastructure. It will identify evacuation needs, designates routes, establishes system standards, and identify needed improvements to the local evacuation system (including route hardening, bridge work, way finding technologies, etc.). It will include goals and policies, implementation strategies, identification of capital projects, and provides the basis for development code provisions necessary to implement effective evacuation route planning and development within the community. A comprehensive TEFIP is essential to the implementation of evacuation route development and improvement in conjunction with the land use review and approval process.

TSUNAMI EVACUATION ASSEMBLY AREAS

An assembly point is a location that has been designated by local authorities for residents and visitors to gather AFTER safely reaching their nearest high ground outside the tsunami zone. Your nearest safety destination (high ground) may not be at an assembly area! If that is the case, wait until the tsunami has ended (12-24 hours) and then head for an assembly area to connect with others.

(Note: Assembly areas are not Evacuation Centers, which are short-term help centers set up AFTER a disaster occurs. Assembly areas are temporary meeting points to meet-up with others during the immediate aftermath of the disaster).
